Program Commencement Dates

Strathfield Private's new graduate program commences in February each year. We offer approximately 4-6 positions annually. The program is offered on a full time and part time basis by negotiation. Graduate Nurses will undertake three to four rotations throughout the year with an optional specialty rotation.

We offer:

- A team of preceptors on each rotation to support and guide the transition from student to Registered Nurse.
- Peer consultations with other Graduates during debriefings and tutorials.
- A Graduate Nurse coordinator dedicated to supporting and providing the new Registered Nurse with the resources and opportunity for clinical and professional development
