Hospital Description

Located in Coffs Harbour, Baringa Private Hospital was opened in 1978 as a 50 bed surgical hospital. Over the years the hospital has grown in size to its current 80 bed capacity, and services now also include medical nursing which incorporates a substantial rehabilitation and palliative care service. Due to expanding surgical services, we have just completed an extensive redevelopment of our theatre complex and now have 4 new state of the art theatres, recovery and CSSD department. We also have a new 5 bed Palliative Care Unit, and a day infusion unit.

A 4 chair unit which treats day patient's requiring intravenous infusions such as blood transfusions and IV drug trials.
