Hospital Description

Lake Macquarie Private is an acute care surgical hospital with the highest average DRG weighting for RHC comprising, 118 licensed beds.

Services include:

- 10 bed Level 2 Intensive Care
- 12 bed Coronary Care
- Six operating theatres
- Angiography lab
- 2 Cardiac Cath labs
- Three 32 bed surgical wards

Case mix includes, but is not limited to, Cardiac surgery, Cardiac diagnostics & interventions, Vascular, Orthopaedics, Urology, General surgery, Colorectal, Maxillofacial, Plastics, Gynae, Breast, Dental, etc.

The hospital is located on the Pacific Highway at Gateshead in the city of Lake Macquarie close to good surfing beaches, beautiful harbour, great restaurants, Hunter Valley vineyards and an abundance of leisure activities.

Program commencement dates

Our program starts in February and depending on vacancies, there may be an additional intake in August.

What kind of rotations do we offer?

Currently we have three rotations – 6 months then 3 and 3 months. However these are negotiable depending on the career path. Operating Theatre New Grads commit to 12 months in theatre and will only be considered if a Theatre placement has been completed in their last year at University (preferably at LMPH).
