Hospital Description

Tamara Private Hospital is a 55 bed acute care rural hospital located in Tamworth (the country music capital) in northern NSW. Tamara has three theatres and a procedure room; a modern 4 bed High Dependency Unit; a maternity unit; a busy refurbished day surgery unit as well as a medical and surgical unit. Tamara Private Hospital is a modern, high technological hospital offering major orthopaedic, urological, laparoscopic abdominal gastric surgery, general surgery, ENT, obstetric and gynaecological services.

The Gradplus program at Tamara Private Hospital commences in February. Up to 3 graduates are taken each year in the general program, and 1 graduate is offered a peri-operative program.

What kind of rotations do we offer?

Quarterly rotations are offered through the medical unit; surgical unit; Day Surgery / Theatre and Post Anaesthetic Care Unit / High Dependency Units.

Brief descriptions of each area you rotate through.

Medical

24 beds

The medical ward has 24 beds. The four bed high dependency is located as a separate unit in the medical ward. There are seven single rooms and eight double rooms. The patient rooms are spacious allowing for ease of patient care.

High Dependency Unit

4 Beds



The High Dependency Unit is a recently refurbished four bed unit with modern cardiac monitors and central monitor. The bed areas are very spacious in line with building codes for intensive care units.

Surgical

17 Beds

The surgical unit has 17 beds. All rooms are single rooms.

Maternity

9 Beds



The maternity unit has nine beds. All rooms are single rooms. There are two delivery suites and a special care nursery.

Day Surgery

The day surgery has recently been refurbished and extended for improved flow of patients. Patients through this unit include endoscopy, dental, orthopaedic and ophthalmology.



Theatre

There are three theatres and a procedure room. The post anaesthetic care unit has nine bays. The theatre complex is spacious and has been recently renovated to improve access for the CSSD unit.

Rotations to other facilities

There are no opportunities to rotate to other facilities, however, Tamara has an onsite physiotherapist and access to education opportunities through our staffing in-service program and HNEAHS.

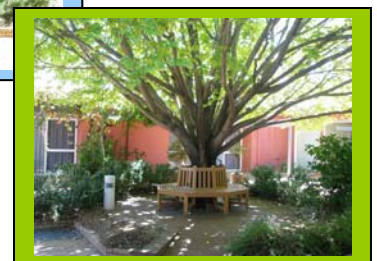
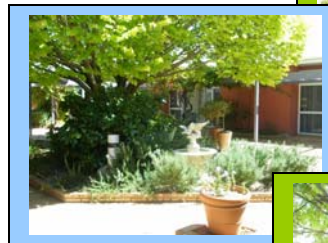
Post graduate courses
